## *Homework*

Because of the nature of all subjects in the faculty, the giving of formal homework – in the traditional sense of the term – is limited.

Some examples of the sort of homework activities given are shown below and do not preclude the giving of formal written homework, should this be appropriate.

### **Art & Design**

- To learn particular concepts used in Art & Design
- To source objects to bring to school for class work – expressive or design work
- To make sketches / drawings of things at home / in the environment as preparation for school based work to follow
- To do research into a particular artist / designer / style using the internet / T.V.

### **Music**

- To learn particular music concepts
- To do revision of work covered in school using CD Rom or internet
- To re-inforce music literacy
- To practise a musical instrument if they have the opportunity

### **Drama**

- To learn particular terms / concepts used in Drama
- To do revision of work covered in school
- To learn a particular script
- To complete folio / written work begun in school.

The above activities are not restricted to any particular year group or course but may be used at all levels as and when appropriate to the work being undertaken in class.
